

When planning exhibits at your trade fair stand, please observe the technical guidelines (link). To avoid endangering persons and objects from exhibits during the ACHEMA, all exhibits must comply with the applicable legal rules and regulations.

In addition, depending on the hazard potential, exhibits are subject to notification and in some cases subject to approval. In this document, you will find relevant properties that cause an obligation to notify or approve an exhibit. The linked factsheets provide further information and, if necessary, contain the form for the notification or the approval process.

Features of the exhibit:

High, heavy, in operation

High
(Higher than 4m)

Heavy
(Exceeding the permissible floor load of the hall, high point loads)

Stability
(Slender exhibits, exhibits with rotational, pendulum or oscillating movements)

In operation
(e.g. unprotected moving parts, openly accessible conveying, feeding or unloading equipment)
The exclusive demonstration of the control display does not fall under this category.

If there is no tested statics or an unfeasible tested statics, the engineering office commissioned for ACHEMA will check the calculation of the statics. These costs will be charged to the exhibitor.
If you need to bring exhibits weighing more than 7,500 kg or 5 metres long or wide into the halls, the transport of which could be problematic during regular assembly, please contact Messe Frankfurt's Logistics Service in good time so that the delivery date can be determined - Tel.: +49 69 7575-6075, Fax.: +49 69 7575-96075, E-mail: logistik@messefrankfurt.com
